The wine culture of the Orient

Lebanon is one of the world's oldest regions for growing grapes to make wine. Digging in the ancient city of Byblos revealed vines that are 5,000 years old. People must have grown grapes and made wine for a very long time. Historically, this area was called Canaan and was known as the „land of red purple“. The Phoenicians, named after Phoinix, the Greek word for purple, were the people who lived here. In this area, Jesus made water into wine. Phoenician traders from the southern Caucasus and Anatolia brought the first vines for wine production into the country. These were probably the *Vitis vinifera pontica*, which is thought to be an ancestor of the Chardonnay vine.

The Phoenicians were skilled at many languages and business, and they ran the most significant transfer stations of their time. These were located in their ports of Beirut, Byblos, Sidon and Tyros where the Incense Road and later the Silk Road intersected with the shipping routes of the Mediterranean. Wine was significant in Phoenician religious practice. In Genesis 14:18, the Phoenician king Melchizedek offered Abraham bread and wine. The Romans created a temple in Baalbek during the 2nd century AD to honour Bacchus - the wine god - which remains today. The harmonious acid cushion leaves the wine crisp at the end.

The first impression of this **fruity** Cabernet is **impulsive and aromatic**. **Intense** nuances of raspberries, blackcurrants combined with spices and cedar wood wrap themselves in the nose. Powerful, well-structured and **full-bodied** on the palate with a **marmalade-like** taste of redcurrants, wild berries and a hint of **fresh** herbs. In addition, all the flavours are underlined by a harmonious vanilla note.

Our oriental winegrowers

Chateau Barka, Barka, Libanon

This winery was founded in 2009 by the five brothers of the Geagea family and named after the land the owners come from: Barka, a mountain village in northern Bekaa, 1450 m above sea level. The highly fertile terroir of international category 1 is one of the components for the exceptional quality of Chateau Barka.

Latourba, West-Bekaa, Libanon

The Latourba winery, founded in 2003, is located in the heart of the country in the southern part of the famous Bekaa plain. Here, about 30 km south of the road from Beirut to Damascus, there is a fantastic view over the mighty Qaraoun reservoir and the foothills of the Lebanon Mountains on one side and the Anti-Lebanon on the other. Latourba's philosophy is to vinify excellent wines with ancient knowledge, craftsmanship and largely natural production.

Coteaux du Liban, Zahle, Libanon

The Coteaux du Liban and Mon Liban winery was founded in 2002 by Nicolas Abou Khater in Zahlé in the Bekaa Valley. Shortly after Nicolas earned his oenology degree at the University of Burgundy, he cultivated his land. After his fatal car accident, his wife, Roula Ghantous Abou Khater, together with their son, Roland Abou Khater, took over her husband's life's work and now runs the winery with admirable determination and great success.

Chateau Cana, Bhamdoun, Libanon

The winery is located in Ras el Harf, in the heart of the Lebanon Mountains. Clos de Cana is first and foremost an economic and social project for development in the district (Caza) of Aley, where the winery is located. Its owner, Dr Fadi Gerges, a dentist by profession, decided in the late 1990s, after deliberations with friends, to produce wine because of the quality of the terroir in the area and the export potential.
